### ABOUT THE JOB

The Technical Programme Manager will be responsible for overseeing the planning, execution, and delivery of complex technical programmes. This role requires a technical understanding of vector control tools, experience of project management within a manufacturing and/or global health context, excellent communication skills, and the ability to work cross-functionally to achieve project goals.

This role is based in Nairobi, Kenya, and will report directly to the Acting Director of Market Development & Access Public Health.

#### **Main responsibilities:**

- Define programme objectives, scope, and deliverables, and create detailed plans with timelines and milestones.
- Collaborate with teams and partners on development of Gantt charts, risk registers, and project documents, including statements of work and contracts, to ensure successful project delivery.
- Track budgets and optimize resources across projects.
- Coordinate cross-functional teams, ensuring alignment and clear communication among stakeholders.
- Manage and provide technical leadership to aspects of programme activities, including the development of vector control products.
- Provide technical support, draft proposals, review data, and assist in strengthening team capacity.
- Manage external scientific studies and oversee project implementation, including budget management for lab and field trials.

- Undergraduate and postgraduate in a relevant subject area or equivalent experience
- Proven commitment to continuous professional development
- Strong understanding of project management strategies and the project lifecycle.
- Proven track record and demonstrable experience of successfully delivering complex technical programmes in tropical global health/vector control.
